Tonight – Scoping Meeting

We appreciate your interest in the Sellwood Bridge Project. The purpose of tonight's meeting – the first of several that will take place over the next 18-months – is to solicit your feedback about issues and concerns that the Project Team should factor in developing and analyzing alternatives. *We won't be identifying bridge alternatives tonight.* That will come at a later date. Tonight's event is a "scoping" meeting designed to share background information about the bridge, go over the project process and schedule, and obtain your feedback on key issues and concerns.

Share your thoughts!

We're here to listen to you! Project team members, Community Task Force members, and Policy Advisory Group representatives are wearing name badges and are available to talk to you about your issues, concerns, and ideas.

A diagram showing the layout of the room and location of topic stations is on the reverse of this handout. Start with the short orientation program and then work your way around the room in a counter-clockwise direction.

How to provide your input

There are several ways to provide your input tonight:

- Talk to us – Project Team members will be jotting down your thoughts and comments on flip pads at the topic stations
- Write on the Issues Wall – A large Issues Wall is located at the back of the room. Add your comments to the issues we have listed. Add new issues if you have any. Then, take your 5 sticky dots out of your folder and "vote" on the items most important to you. You can put all five dots on one subject, or spread your dots around.
- Fill out a comment form – Comment forms are included in your folders also. Fill it out and drop it in one of the comment form drop boxes located around the room.
- Fill out a survey – Hard copy versions of our online survey are available at the Website Demo station. *You don't need to fill one out if you have already taken the online survey.* If you haven't, feel free to fill one out and put it in one of the drop boxes.
