Thank you for taking the time to join us. Tonight we are asking for your input on the **bridge types** that you prefer for a replacement Sellwood Bridge and dedicated bicycle/pedestrian crossing.

There are two parts to tonight's meeting: a **brief orientation** including a question and answer session, and an **open house**. We suggest you start with the orientation and then work your way around the room counter-clockwise ending at the Feedback station.

Orientation

Open House

The Open House stations include:

- **Bridge Alternatives** (displays featuring the five alternatives being studied in the DEIS as well as options for bicyclists and pedestrians)
- **Bridge Types** (displays of the six bridge types for motor vehicles and two additional types for a bike/pedestrian crossing)
- **Financing Options** (displays about preliminary plans for funding this project)
- **Feedback** (displays that will help you fill out your comment form).

Also, feel free to write your **comments** on the flip charts provided at each station.

Project staff and CTF members are wearing name badges and available to discuss the project with you. In addition, several members of the **Bridge Type Working Group** – the committee of architects, planners and interested citizens who studied and recommended the bridge types you will see tonight – are here and happy to talk with you. They can be recognized by the **gold stars** on their name badges.
