What's new with the Sellwood Bridge Project?

Early in 2009, with input from citizens and the community task force, a group of elected officials recommended a preferred alternative to replace the Sellwood Bridge.

Since then, the project team has been working to refine the plan for the new bridge to comply with various agency policies and regulations, including:

- Refining access to properties with driveways on SW Macadam Avenue
- Mitigating historic and natural resource impacts
- Improving bicycle and pedestrian facilities on the west side
- Narrowing the bridge cross section near the west side interchange
- Planning more detailed connections to transit and trails

The project's next step is to complete a Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), a plan the federal government must approve before construction can begin. As we start work on the Final EIS, we want to answer your questions about the latest project refinements at the September 30th Open House.
